Note for Dormitory Residents  
During the Declaration of the State of Emergency

The national government declared another "State of Emergency in Response to the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)" for Tokyo and several other prefectures.

We ask all residents at the International House to continue to cooperate in preventing the spread of the virus by raising awareness on "protecting yourself from infection and preventing infection transmission to others."

- ◆ Refrain from going out unless absolutely necessary and cooperate in preventing the spread of the virus. Please refrain from going out especially after 20:00.
- ◆ Take actions to prevent the virus spread such as by taking care of your physical condition, hand washing and wearing a mask. If you feel unwell, please consult a doctor, etc., and do not attend university nor go outside the residence.
- ◆ Please take great care and attention not to contract the virus from off-campus activities (including part-time jobs and volunteer activities).
- ◆ Refrain from gathering to eat or drink with others regardless of whether they belong to TUAT or not; OR whether it is in a restaurant or in someone's private house/residence, etc. In particular, we strongly request all residents to refrain from gathering for meals/etc. in the rooms or other areas of the International House, as this may cause outbreaks of the infectious disease, and in the worst case, we may have to close the International House.
- ◆ If you are confirmed with COVID-19, taken a PCR test or identified as a Close Contact to a COVID-19 positive individual, immediately report it to the University.
