1. The academic calendar dates are subject to change during the year.
2. The Department of Industrial Technology and Innovation in the Graduate School of Engineering follows the academic calendar that applies to the Graduate School and Faculty of Engineering, in principle. However, the calendar may be altered due to possible classes held during evening hours and on Saturdays.
3. The Cooperative Division of Veterinary Sciences and the Cooperative Department of Veterinary Medicine follow the academic calendar that applies to the Graduate School and Faculty of Agriculture, in principle. However, the academic calendar may be altered due to the necessity of classes in conjunction with Iwate University.
4. The Faculty and Graduate school of Agriculture only: classes are cancelled on December 7 due to the graduate school entrance examinations. February 1 is the supplementary class day for Tuesday-cancelled classes. And, February 7 is the substitution/supplementary class day for Thursday-cancelled classes if a course did not fulfill the required credit hours in the third quarter.
5. The Spring/Summer Semester is from April 1 to Semester 30, and the Fall/Winter Semester is from October 1 to March 31 of the following year.
6. Intensive lectures may be provided even during summer, winter, and spring break periods at the discretion of instructors.
7. The Academic Year 2023-2024 consists of four quarters: First Quarter (April 1 to August 1, 2023), Second Quarter (August 2 to September 30, 2023), Third Quarter (October 1, 2023 to February 7, 2024), and Fourth Quarter (February 8 to March 31, 2024). The duration of each quarter may be altered each academic year.
